Since 2003 the Scugog Fire Department has conducted the Alarmed for Life Smoke Alarm Program. ATTENTION POOL OWNERS

Did you know all pools require enclosures and permits. The Township of Scugog requires that a permit be obtained prior to the installation of a swimming pool. In addition, pool enclosure and fencing is also required.

Failing to obtain a permit for your pool or supplying adequate enclosure, may result in charges being laid in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal By-law.
