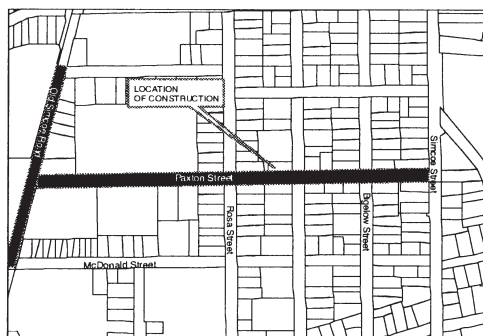
Notice of Public Open House – Paxton Street

The Township of Scugog and the Regional Municipality of Durham will be commencing road reconstruction on Paxton Street from Old Simcoe Road to Simcoe Street in the fall. The works consist of the replacement of watermain and sanitary sewers (from Old Simcoe Road to Perry Street only), construction of curb, gutter and storm sewers, and rehabilitation of the road and sidewalks. Also, a new sanitary sewer will be constructed on Old Simcoe Road over distance of approximately 250m from the pumping station at McDonald Street to an easement 90m north of Paxton Street. In addition, construction of a new concrete sidewalk along the west side of Ottawa Street between Queen Street and Highway 7A over a distance of approximately 270m is included.

The Township and Region are hosting a Public Open House on Wednesday, August 27, 2008 at the Municipal Office (181 Perry Street) between 6 p.m. – 8 p.m. We will be available that evening to show you the plans and answer any questions you may have about the works.

Township Signs

Please note that it is the intent of the Township to ensure that all Portable signs are in compliance to the Sign By-Law no later than August 31, 2008. After that date enforcement of the Sign By-Law will be undertaken.

A-Frame and Menu Board signs require annual licensing and must be sized to meet the Sign By-law Requirements. Signs within the main central area must be no larger than 1.2 square metres (or 4 square feet), signs outside of the main central area must be no larger than 33 inches wide and 43 inches in height.

Further that if you own a retail business in the Township and did not obtain a Permit for your Business' sign you should make that application to the Township Building Department as soon as possible. All signs for a business must have a permit issued by the Building Department.

In addition, an Amendment to the Sign By-Law has made it lawful in some instances to erect and maintain a Billboard sign. Please contact the Municipal Law Enforcement Office at 905-985-7346 for further information and requirements.
