### TOWNSHIP SIGNS

Please note that it is the intent of the Township to ensure that all Portable signs are in compliance to the Sign By-Law no later than August 31, 2008. After that date enforcement of the Sign By-Law will be undertaken.

A-Frame and Menu Board signs require annual licensing and must be sized to meet the Sign By-law Requirements. Signs within the main central area must be no larger than 1.2 square metres (or 4 square feet), signs outside of the main central area must be no larger than 33 inches wide and 43 inches in height.

Further that if you own a retail business in the Township and did not obtain a Permit for your Business' sign you should make that application to the Township Building Department as soon as possible. All signs for a business must have a permit issued by the Building Department.

In addition, an Amendment to the Sign By-Law has made it lawful in some instances to erect and maintain a Billboard sign. Please contact the Municipal Law Enforcement Office at 905-985-7346 for further information and requirements.

### EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

#### VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER

The Township of Scugog Fire Department is currently accepting applications for volunteer firefighters for both stations – Station 1 in Port Perry and Station 2 in Caesarea. Applicants must be at least 18 years of age and be able to meet the following criteria:

1. Live within 2 km of Station 1 (Port Perry) OR live within 5 km of Station 2 (Caesarea) Note: Applications from Blackstock and Nestleton areas will be accepted for Station 2.
2. Hold a valid Ontario Driver's Licence, a good driving record, and be prepared to produce a statement of your driving record as well as a criminal background check.
3. Have a Grade 12 Diploma (or education equivalent).
4. Understand and be able to communicate clearly in English (oral & written).
5. Be in good health and be capable of handling intense sustained physical effort. You will be required to submit to physical fitness testing, medical testing and a swim test at York University as part of the application process.

Full training and equipment is supplied to all successful candidates. Training to commence later in the fall. Deadline to apply is September 30, 2008. Applications will be available at Station 1 (30 Crandell Street, Port Perry) or the Municipal Office (181 Perry Street, Port Perry) as well as online ([www.scugog.ca](http://www.scugog.ca)). Previous applicants are welcome to re-apply. We thank all applicants for their interest, however, only those selected for an interview will be contacted.
