### Winter Reminders Parking Reminder To All Residents of Scugog

Parking on any street in the Township is prohibited between 2:00 am and 6:00 am from December 1st to April 1st. This By-law infraction will be strictly enforced. Also should snow clearing crews have to go around your parked vehicle, it may ticketed and may also be subject to impounding at anytime during snow clearing activities. Please help our Road crews to keep our streets free and clear of snow and ice by keeping your parked vehicles off the roads.

### Snow Removal from Driveways and Sidewalks

Reminder to residents that snow and ice must be cleared from sidewalks within 24 hrs after a snowfall. Also, when removing snow from driveways or sidewalks, do not place snow on the roadways. It is unsafe, inconvenient and illegal.
