## NOTICES

### NOTICE OF THE PASSING OF A DEVELOPMENT CHARGES BY-LAW BY THE MUNICIPALITY

TAKE NOTICE that the Township of Scugog passed Development Charge By-law No. 72-09 on the 22nd day of June, 2009 under Section 2 of the Development Charges Act, 1997.

AND TAKE NOTICE that any person or organization may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board under Section 14 of the Act, in respect of the Development Charges By-law, by filing with the Clerk on or before the 4th day of August, 2009 a notice of appeal setting out the objection to the By-law and the reasons supporting the objection.

The schedule of development charges imposed by the By-law is as follows:

The development charge to be imposed on new residential development other than that specifically exempted by the Development Charges Act shall, as of July 1, 2009, be \$11,905 on each new single and semi-detached unit, \$9,442 for rows & other multiple dwellings and \$6,612 for an apartment.

The development charge to be imposed in respect of non-residential development, other than that specifically exempted by the Development Charges Act or the By-law shall, as of July 1, 2009, be:

- \$62.92 per square metre of gross floor area for commercial development;
- \$40.13 per square metre of gross floor area for institutional development; and
- \$6.64 per square metre of gross floor area for industrial development.

The development charges are imposed on all lands in the Township of Scugog.

A copy of the complete Development Charge By-law is available for examination in the office of the Clerk located at 181 Perry Street, Port Perry, during regular office hours.

Notice of a proposed by-law amending the Development Charges By-law or the passage of such an amending by-law is not required to be given to any person or organization, other than to the Clerk of the municipality, unless the person or organization gives the Clerk a written request for notice of any amendments to the Development Charges By-law and has provided a return address.

### REGARDING AN AMENDMENT TO THE TOWNSHIP OF SCUGOG YARD AND WASTE BY-LAW

TAKE NOTICE that the Corporation of the Township of Scugog has passed a By-Law to amend the Yard and Waste By-Law of the Township of Scugog. The amendment has:

- re-defined the definition of "Property" to include all properties in the Township of Scugog including vacant lands, ditches and boulevards.
- added derelict vehicles, machinery and their component parts to the definition of "Debris"

This change will require all property owners and developers to maintain their properties including the municipal boulevards and ditches adjacent to their properties to an acceptable minimum standard.
