Take Notice that the Township of Scugog deemed the following applications to amend Township Zoning By-Law 75-80 (as amended) "Complete" Applications pursuant to Section 34 of The Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, C. P.13 and Township of Scugog By-Law Number 33-08, on the 28th day of September, 2009.

Purpose and Effect of the Proposed Amendments

The purpose of the proposed amendment is to rezone the lands from the Urban Residential Type Two (R2) Zone to a General Commercial (C3) Exception Zone. If approved, the zoning by-law amendment would permit a residential dwelling unit on the second storey, together with the following uses on the ground floor:

- A Bank or Financial Institution;
- A Business, Professional or Administrative Office;
- A Personal Service Shop;
- A Retail Commercial Establishment; and,
- A Day Spa.

The application also seeks relief from the parking provisions to provide for a total of four (4) on-site spaces and other related exemptions.

The purpose of the proposed amendment is to rezone a portion of the lands from the Development Holding (H) and Urban Residential Type Three (R3) Zones to an Urban Residential Type Three (R3) Exception Zone. If approved, the zoning by-law amendment would extend the R3 Zone to include the as-built location of the existing dwelling and sewage disposal system and permit the construction of a proposed detached accessory structure with gross floor areas of 458.94m² (4940 square feet) on the ground floor and 81.75m² (880 square feet) on a second floor mezzanine with an overall building height of 9.45m (31 feet).

Any person or agency may attend and provide representation at the Public Meeting and/or make written representation prior to the public meeting. If you wish to be notified of the approval of the Zoning By-Law Amendments, you must make a written request to the Clerk of the Township of Scugog prior to a decision being made.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to Section 34 (10.7) of the Planning Act, the application files relating to these Zoning By-Law Amendments are available for public inspection at the Municipal Office, 181 Perry Street, Port Perry, during regular office hours (Monday to Friday 8:30AM to 4:30PM). If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Township of Scugog before a by-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of the Township of Scugog to the Ontario Municipal Board.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting, or make written submissions to Township of Scugog before a by-law is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

Port Perry Downtown Waterfront Revitalization Project Water Street Reconstruction and Waterfront Trail

The Township of Scugog has awarded a contract to Ron Robinson Limited for the reconstruction of Water Street from Queen Street to North Street and the

development of a public square and waterfront trail in Palmer Park. The Water Street work includes the replacement of sanitary sewers and water mains, construction of curb, gutter and storm sewers, rehabilitation of the road and sidewalks, installation of a roundabout and streetscaping. The trail component includes the construction of an interlock brick walkway along the waterfront and a public square at the foot of Queen Street, landscaping and new streetlights.

Sidewalk and Curb Repairs

The Township of Scugog has awarded a contract to Miwel Construction Limited for the replacement of sidewalk and/or curb on the following roads in Port Perry:

- Applewood Crescent, Chester Crescent, Cochrane Street, Commons Boulevard, Heath Crescent, Kellett Street, McDonald Street, Queen Street, Old Simcoe Road, Orchard Road, Walsh Drive, Waterbury Crescent

The construction of a new sidewalk on Old Simcoe Road from Chimney Hill Way to south of Reach Street is also included in this project.

We realize construction work is disruptive and will make every effort to complete the projects as quickly, efficiently and safely as possible.

Tom Thomson on Display at the Township of Scugog Municipal Building

In 1904, Tom was 27 years of age and living in Toronto working as an artist. He took advantage of this time to make frequent visits to the Scarborough Bluffs and east to Durham Region. It was at this time in his life that he likely made his way to Scugog and painted such works as 'Near Lake Scugog' and 'Evening Lake Scugog'. A sampling of photographs taken during Mr. Thomson's time in Scugog is now currently on display in the lobby of the Township of Scugog building.
