The purpose of the Heritage Scugog Awards is to acknowledge, recognize and reward the hard work that goes on in the Township of Scugog to preserve and promote our heritage.

The Heritage Scugog Awards are a component of the Township of Scugog's Heritage Strategic Plan. The recognition of groups, individuals, and stakeholders who contribute to heritage in Scugog is an integral part of sustainability and promotion of heritage through this plan.

Community heritage resources are the physical and cultural elements that make each community what it is. They are the tangible embodiments of intangible historical, cultural, aesthetic and social values. They give a community its particular sense of time and place, and they are the cultural expressions of what that place is.

Our heritage tells us who we are, where we have come from and what we have accomplished. Heritage is a source of strength and confidence that puts the changes of society into perspective and helps us build a better future.

## **AWARD CATEGORIES:**

1. **Architectural Conservation & Craftsmanship Award**  
For excellence in the preservation or adaptive re-use of a building 40 years or older.
2. **Heritage Integration Award**  
Recognizes a sensitive addition to a heritage building or modern infill building that is complementary to the heritage character of a specific area.
3. **Media Award**  
For a work of non-fiction about Scugog's archaeological, built, cultural and/or natural heritage. Projects such as films, websites, maps and exhibits are eligible.
4. **Publication & Research Award**  
For a work of non-fiction about Scugog's archaeological, built, cultural and/or natural heritage.
5. **Agricultural Heritage Award**  
Recognizes an individual or group that has worked to preserve and promote Scugog's agricultural heritage.
6. **Mayor's Community Heritage Award**  
Awarded to a volunteer-based organization that promotes or protects heritage within Scugog.

## **SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:**

**Provide a brief, one page summary describing the role of the nominees and their contribution to heritage within the Township of Scugog. The summary should describe the challenges that the project presented and the response to the challenge.**

**Categories 1 and 2**, please submit a written description of the nature and extent of the project, relating specifically to the relevant category, and provide visual documentation in the form of plans, sketches and/or photographs. Comparative illustrations or photos clearly indicating before and after should be included.

**Categories 3, 4, 5, and 6**, please include a detailed description of the individual or group's activities and how this has promoted heritage conservation. Include biographical information, media coverage and photographs.
